



## Rams Claim Conference Tournament Title

The Scott City Rams battled the Chaffee Red Devils on Friday 2/6 in the finals of the Scott/Mississippi Conference Tournament at Scott County Central High School. The Rams were able to win their second consecutive Conference Tournament Championship, to go along with their second consecutive Conference Regular Season Championship, defeating the Red Devils **63-39**.

Scott City's defense once again set the tone, limiting Chaffee to single digits in the first quarter, resulting in a **14-7** lead. The Rams were able to outscore the Red Devils **17-13** in the second quarter, taking a **31-20** lead into halftime. Scott City built on their lead in the third quarter, establishing an **11-8** edge and stretching out to a **42-28** lead. Just like the first time these two teams met, the Rams were able to put the game away in the fourth quarter, posting a **21-11** advantage.

Scott City's defense and rebounding were the difference in the game, holding Chaffee to **31%** shooting and winning the rebounding battle **38-21**. Scott City (**17-3**) will travel to Cape Central High School on Tuesday to take on the Tigers at 7:30 p.m.
