

## Rams Outlast Jefferson

The Scott City Rams traveled to Festus on Wednesday evening to take on the Jefferson BlueJays, and were able to eke out a 57-52 win.

Scott City was able to put together a 16-13 lead after the first quarter, and outscored Jefferson 16-12 in the second quarter to hold a 32-25 lead at halftime.
