



Rams Win at Home

The Scott City Rams returned home for a date with the St. Vincent Indians on Friday January 23rd, and were able to come away with a **73-64** win.

The first quarter was a back and forth affair, with the Rams holding a slight **17-16** advantage. Scott City was able to gain some separation in the second quarter as they outscored St. Vincent **22-12** to take a **39-28** lead into halftime. The Rams outscored the Indians **20-14** in the third quarter to build a **59-42** lead. St. Vincent was able to outscore the Rams in the fourth quarter, **22-14**, but the final margin was the closest they were able to get.

Top Performers

- **Max Snider:** Led all scorers with **24 points**, including three 3-pointers.

- **Carter Burger:** Scored **14 points** while grabbing **6 rebounds** and collecting **4 steals**.
